Awards of up to \$1500 will support travel costs and/or conference registration fees of a Fellow, Resident, or Post-doc.

Awards of up to \$1000 will support travel costs and/or conference registration fees of a graduate student.

Awards will be capped based on available budget.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must have been accepted to present a poster or talk at the conference/workshop listed below.
- Applicants must submit application at least four (4) weeks prior to conference/workshop travel.
- Awards are limited to one trainee per affiliated faculty member per year.
- Awarded investigators are expected to:
 - Present research at the conference/workshop.
 - Acknowledge the CFNRE in all work: This project has been supported in part by the West Virginia University Center for Foundational Neuroscience Research and Education.
