
Dress Code

HSTA Students are expected to dress and groom themselves in a manner conducive to the educational environment, prioritizing health, safety, and overall well-being. Attire that is distracting or inappropriate is not permitted. The following guidelines are to help students adhere to the dress code:

- Clothing may not depict, imply, advertise, or advocate illegal, violent, or lewd conduct, or use of alcohol, tobacco, weapons, or drug use.
- Students may not wear sunglasses, hats, and/or hoodies with the hood up in banquets/classrooms/labs/evening activities.
- Students may not wear blankets or pajamas/slippers in banquets/classrooms/labs/ evening activities.
- Swimwear, when necessary, should only be worn in the pool area.
- In all lab areas, closed toe shoes and long pants **MUST** be worn.
- Clothing may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
- Clothing and accessories that endanger student and/or staff safety may not be worn.
- Students are to bring clothing that is comfortable and appropriate for: walking, running, sitting, reaching, and bending as well as cool mornings, rain, warm days, and air conditioning.
- Inappropriate fashion not specifically covered in the above guidelines shall be addressed by field sites, teachers, faculty, mentors and/or HSTA staff.

If a student's appearance and/or attire disrupts the educational environment or poses a threat to health and safety, they will be asked to change into appropriate clothing.

First aid items
Sunscreen
Cell phones are allowed but must be turned off during instructional sessions or when requested by staff.
(Student must adhere to each Institution's cell phone and internet policy.)
Spending money (for special events or outings/Not Required)
o <u>NOT</u> allowed: Ordering Out (DoorDash, Walmart, Uber Eats, etc.) and/or items dropped off by
parents/guardians/etc.
All students attending all camps need to know their WVEIS number.

NO TVs or Gaming Systems ALLOWED

Summer Camp Contract

I understand that the staff of the summer program strives to maintain a strong quality program. I understand that I am expected to act appropriately - always maintaining good and responsible behavior. I understand and agree to abide by all the HSTA Rules and Regulations, some of which are:

- 1. I am required to submit all summer forms required of me on time or I will not be allowed to attend.
- 2. I will be required to go home if I sustain an injury during the summer program that impacts my mobility.
- 3. I am required to attend, participate, and be punctual for all classes, workshops, and other scheduled activities.
- 4. I am required to stay in the assigned residence hall.
- 5. I will not damage or deface property. If I do deface property, I will assume financial responsibility for the damaged items.
- 6. I will not consume or possess any form of tobacco or nicotine delivery system, alcoholic beverage, or illegal drug.
- 7. I will not take other's possessions without the owner's permission (stealing).
- 8. I will not disrespect or disregard HSTA staff, mentors, administrators, teachers or university faculty.
- 9. I will not bring weapons of any kind to HSTA Summer Institute at any participating campus.
- 10. I understand that females are not permitted in the male sleeping areas (i.e. rooms/floors) and males are not permitted in the female sleeping areas.
- 11. I agree to follow my school's 'Acceptable Computer/Internet Use' policy as well as the 'WVU Computer/Internet Use' policy for all HSTA activities.
- 12. I agree to abide by the set HSTA Dress Code.
- 13. I agree to follow safety guidelines and recommendations from the HSTA Instructor and teachers for all summer activities.
- 14. I agree I will not be permitted to attend, or leave campus for, other programs or activities not related to HSTA while at the HSTA Summer Institute. No outside visitors are permitted.
- 15. I agree to follow all other rules and regulations implemented by HSTA.
