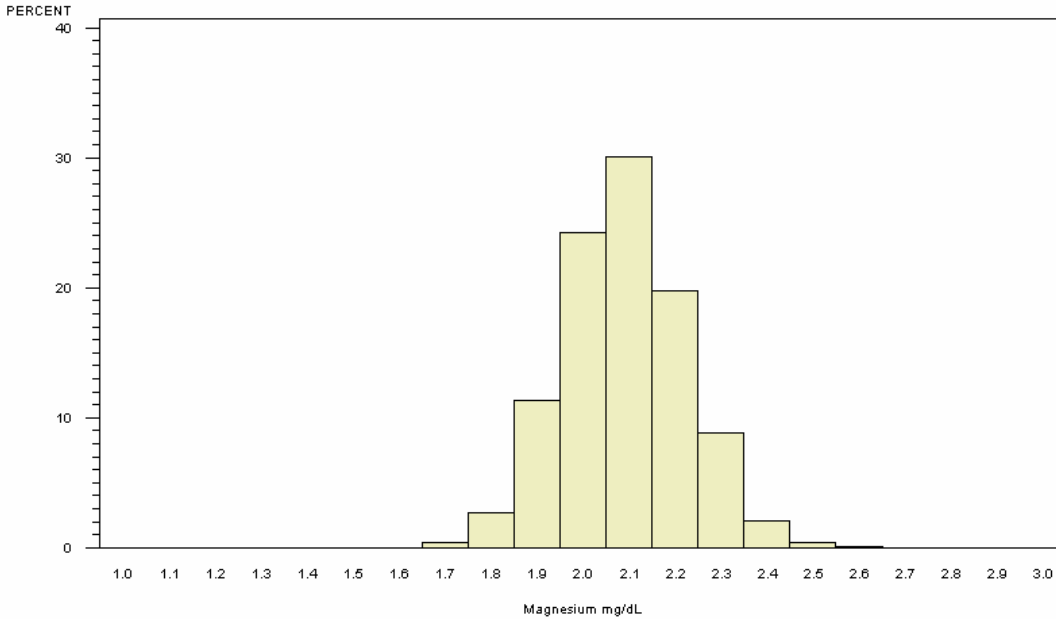

PARTICIPANTS=4443, MEAN=2.09, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.14

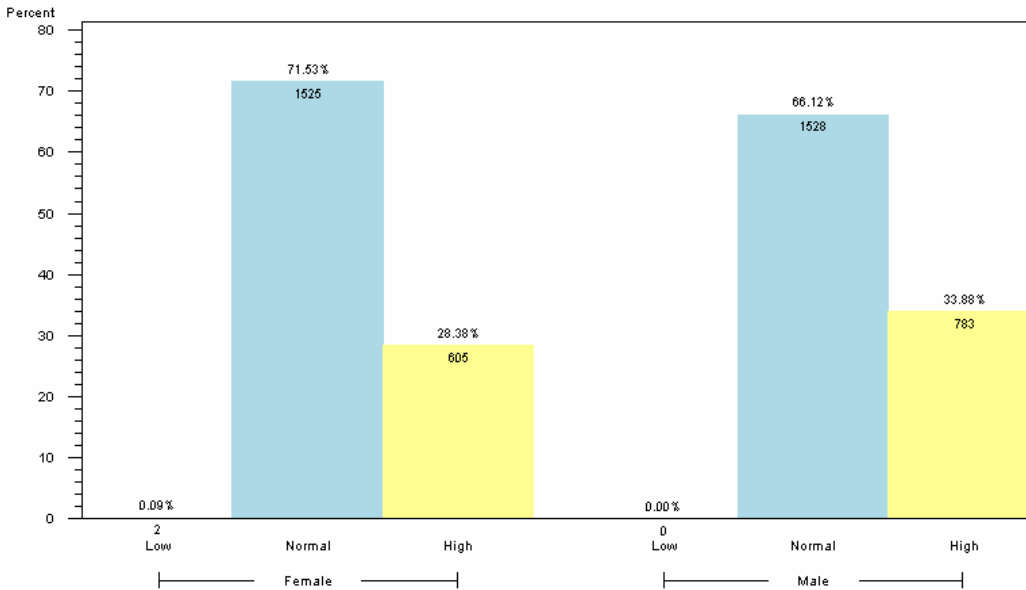
1st PERCENTILE=1.80, MEDIAN=2.10, 99th PERCENTILE=2.40

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 70% of participants 6-12 years of age had normal serum magnesium levels. A higher proportion of boys compared to girls had elevated magnesium levels.
